- 1983 TISL (Telecommunication and Information Sciences Laboratory) Mission: Basic research in Telecommunication and **Information Sciences**
- 1989 CECASE (Center for Computer-aided Systems Engr.) Mission: Develop and transfer systems engineering methods and software to Kansas Companies to increase their competitiveness (Application area: telecommunication and Information Systems)
- 1997- TISL+CECASE = ITTC

To be a world class center excelling in basic research, technology development and transfer of viable Telecommunication and Information Technologies




#### ITTC: Focus Areas

- SW and HW Prototyping (support, toolkits)




# University Research Organization


# ITTC R/D&C Organization





## R/D&C Core Expenditures


#### 6 year total = \$11.76 Million


